



All in a Row

Just like “Naughts and Crosses”, this involves trying to get your symbol (o or x) in a row, column or diagonal.

Some things to note:

- (a) Players alternate their turns, x or o, until the board is filled.
- (b) In the case of the 5 x 5 grid shown below, players score points as follows:
 - (i) 3 in a row = 1 point
 - (ii) 4 in a row = 2 points
 - (iii) 5 in a row = 3 points.
- (c) A x or o may be used in more than one group. (eg In a group with 3 across and in another group with 4 down.)

Example
